The B-N Mosquito Abatement District (MAD) had detected a large mosquito hatch. This hatch is very large and widespread due to the heavy rains and flooding of last week. The MAD is providing this notice to area residents so they can take precautions to protect themselves from mosquito bites and, possibly, a mosquito-borne disease such as West Nile Virus (WNV). People are encouraged to wear long sleeve/pant clothing when outside at dusk and evening; to use mosquito repellent; and to stay indoors during peak mosquito activity, dusk and evening. Make sure your children are protected when playing outside. Report areas of standing water to the MAD.

The MAD provides community mosquito control services to Barberton, Norton and Doylestown. If you live in these communities and are experiencing a mosquito nuisance, please call us at 330-848-2623. We are providing extra sprayings in neighborhoods that have an unusually high mosquito population. Tonight, Aug 28, 2011, we will be treating the entire community of Norton.
